Autumn Walk

Pattern by Rebecca Sweinhagen - Urban Tribal Wear



The perfect mitten to keep your hands and wrists cozy while your fingers can stay active! Wear these luxuriously soft mittens alone or over fitted leather gloves for extra warmth. You'll still be able to dial your cell phone, handle your car keys, and more...or ignore the modern conveniences and enjoy a lovely evening walk through the brisk autumn air while still staying cozy.

Womens' (Mens')

Materials

2 skeins Catalina Baby Alpaca
Chunky (3.5 oz, 109 yards,
100% baby alpaca)

Needles

Size 7 double point needles

**Gauge 4.5 stitches & 5.5 rows
= 1" over stockinette stitch**

Begin at the cuff of the mitten

CO 32 (36) sts. Divide evenly
onto 3 dpn as follows:

Needle 1: 12 (12)

Needle 2: 12 (12)

Needle 3: 8 (12)

Join being careful not to twist
stitches

Knit 3 rounds

Work 3 rounds in seed stitch

Begin cable pattern:

Knit 3 rounds

*slip 2 stitches onto
cable needle and hold at the
front of the work, k the next 2
sts, repeat from * to the end of
the round

Repeat 3 more times

Knit 5 rounds

Begin gusset shaping

Inc 1 st in the 1st 2 sts, k to end
of round

Knit 3 rounds

Inc in the 1st st, k2, inc, k to end
of round

Knit 3 rounds

Inc, k4, inc, k to end of round

Knit 3 rounds

Inc, k6, inc, k to end of round

Knit 1 round

Place 10 thumb sts on holder.

CO 4 sts. Join.

Knit 3 rounds

Work 3 rounds in 1x1 rib.

Bind off all stitches loosely in
rib stitch.

Work thumb

Divide thumb sts onto 2 dpn.

Pick up 6 sts around thumb
opening. Knit to the end of the
round

K2 tog, k2, k2 tog, k to end of
round

Work 2 rounds in 1x1 rib

Bind off all stitches loosely in
rib stitch.

Weave in loose ends and enjoy!

More Ideas from Urban Tribal Wear

Work the cuff in a contrasting color

Sew beads along the edges of the
cables

Work the cable pattern for 6" for a
longer cuff

Use a contrasting color to "tip" the
mittens as the first 2 rows and the
last 2 rows only.

Use leftover yarn to make a 3 stitch
I-cord that is long enough to reach
from mitten to mitten across the
back of your coat. Pull the mittens
through your coat and you're sure
not to lose them!
